3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Transparency in On-
- 5 line Retailing Act".

6 SEC. 2. DISCLOSURE OF COUNTRY OF ORIGIN BY ONLINE 7 RETAILERS.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—A person that, through an inter9 net website, sells an article of foreign origin imported into
10 the United States shall mark in a conspicuous place on

that website, and in the same language that is used on
 the rest of that website, the name of the country of origin
 of that article.

4 (b) ENFORCEMENT.—

5 (1) UNFAIR AND DECEPTIVE ACTS OR PRAC6 TICES.—A violation of subsection (a) shall be treated
7 as a violation of a rule defining an unfair or decep8 tive act or practice prescribed under section
9 18(a)(1)(B) of the Federal Trade Commission Act
10 (15 U.S.C. 57a(a)(1)(B)).

11 (2) POWERS OF FEDERAL TRADE COMMIS12 SION.—

13 (A) IN GENERAL.—The Federal Trade 14 Commission shall enforce this Act in the same 15 manner, by the same means, and with the same 16 jurisdiction, powers, and duties as though all 17 applicable terms and provisions of the Federal 18 Trade Commission Act (15 U.S.C. 41 et seq.) 19 were incorporated into and made a part of this 20 Act.

(B) PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES.—Any
person that violates subsection (a) shall be subject to the penalties, and entitled to the privileges and immunities, provided in the Federal
Trade Commission Act (15 U.S.C. 41 et seq.).
